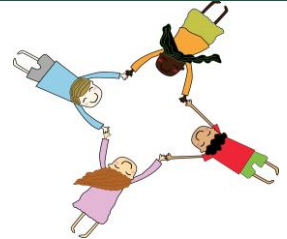
Long Term Plan for Networks
